CALL TO ORDER/ROLL CALL

However, Superintendent Hermonson encouraged the public to fill out the survey, as it helps collect consistent data, even if they were able to attend the public meeting tonight.
- One resident voiced that his grandson would like to see more soccer-related spaces, activities, clinics and coaching opportunities throughout Streamwood. His family currently travels to Schaumburg for their soccer needs.
- One resident voiced their opinion that a community garden would be nice and she would be willing to assist with getting something like that up and running.
- One resident voiced their opinion that the paths and walkways should be upgraded and expanded; several other residents echoed that comment and added that mile markers would be nice.
- Landscape Architect Brusseau went over the all of the examples of what could go in the possible play area features. He stated it could be anything from pollinator gardens to a challenger course.
- Superintendent Hermonson and Landscape Architect Brusseau went up to the visual boards with the residents to go over possibilities and the conceptual master plan options of Commissioners' Park.
- Superintendent Hermonson stated staff members would stay until 7:30 p.m. to ensure all residents had an opportunity to voice all of their opinions and would stick around in case anyone showed up late.

ADJOURNMENT


At 6:55 p.m., President Janiec moved to adjourn and the motion was seconded by Commissioner Wright. A voice vote was unanimous for approval; motion carried.
