

**STREAMWOOD PARK DISTRICT
ORDINANCE NO. 2018-6-2-O
AN ORDINANCE CHANGING THE NAME OF
AQUARIUS PARK TO COMMISSIONERS' PARK**

WHEREAS, the Streamwood Park District may establish, repeal, modify and enforce rules and regulations intended to allow it to maintain and control its property and parks in accordance with Section 8-1 of the Park District Code (70 ILCS 1205/8-1); and

WHEREAS, the Streamwood Park District owns and operates a park located at 81 Linden Lane, currently known as “Aquarius Park”; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Park Commissioners desires to change the name of said Park to recognize and commemorate all of the public servants who have dedicated their time to serve on the Park District Board without compensation; and

WHEREAS, on April 28, 2009 the Board of Park Commissioners adopted Ordinance 2009-4-1-O, which adopted the District’s Park, Recreation Area and Facility Naming Policy; and

WHEREAS, Section 5.2 of Ordinance 2009-4-1-O authorizes the renaming of parks and establishes procedures under which renaming parks may be accomplished; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Park Commissioners hereby find and determine it to be in the best interest of the Park District to rename Aquarius Park;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Board of Park Commissioners of the Streamwood Park District, Cook County, Illinois, as follows:

Section 1. Recitals. The foregoing recitals shall be and are hereby incorporated into and made a part of this Ordinance as if fully set forth in this Section 1.

Section 2. Renaming Aquarius Park. Upon adoption of this Ordinance, the Streamwood Park District park located at 81 Linden Lane, Streamwood, Illinois shall be known as “Commissioners’ Park”. The Executive Director and/or his designee is hereby authorized to take all action necessary to make the Streamwood community aware of the name change, including, but not limited to replacing

signage at the park and updating publications, websites, and social media sites currently displaying the former name of the park.

Section 3. Severability. That if any section, subdivision, sentence or phrase of this Ordinance or the adopted naming policy is for any reason held to be void, invalid, or unconstitutional, such decision shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions of this Ordinance or the policy.

Section 4. Repeal and Savings Clause. All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed; provided, however, that nothing herein contained shall affect any rights, actions or causes of action which shall have accrued to the Park District prior to the effective date of this Ordinance.

Section 5. Effectiveness. That this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, approval and publication in pamphlet form as provided by law.
