A. Weed Control Strategies

Commissioner Janiec wondered if we are allowed to spray in play areas which Superintendent of Parks & Planning Gorczyca responded that we can as long as we notify the neighbors and also today the products dry within an hour.

Commissioner Keating expressed his appreciation to Superintendent of Parks & Planning Gorczyca for all the work he did on trying to rectify this problem.

Commissioner Armstrong also expressed her appreciation of the memorandum but still wanted to know what can be done now to deal with the weed problem. Superintendent of Parks & Planning Gorczyca informed her that we have hired some temporary staff whose main focus is weed control in the parks that still have a problem.

President Wright thanked Superintendent of Parks & Planning Gorczyca for his hard work on this issue. He suggested that the Park District contact our local newspaper to let the residents know what we are doing regarding the weed control problem.
