DEPARTMENTS/DIRECTOR'S REPORT

- A. Superintendent of Recreation Muenz informed the Board that he, along with staff, are in the process of interviewing for the open Athletic Manager position and hopes to have someone in place very soon.
- **B.** Superintendent of Recreation Muenz stated that a new credit card system has been installed and we have been working through a few kinks and everything should be up and running for the future.
- C. Superintendent of Recreation Muenz said that staff has reviewed removing lifeguards at the pool for some specific hours during the week with PDRMA and Starguards approval.
- **D.** Superintendent of Recreation Muenz said that Recreation Managers Upshaw and Saros recently graduated from the IPRA Leadership Academy. We are proud of them both for their work over the past year.
- **E.** Superintendent of Recreation Muenz informed the Board that staff combined the Mom/Son Hop and the Marvelous Dancing Heroes events and there were 38 participants. We are planning to build on the event and keep the theme for next year.
- F. Superintendent of Recreation Muenz said that Human Resources Manager Rose Baltazar and Marketing & Communications Manager Jean Stone are setting up a job fair that both Recreation and Parks will participate in. The fair takes place this Thursday from 4-8 p.m. and Saturday from 10 am 2 p.m. at Park Place.
- G. Superintendent of Recreation Muenz stated that spring swim lessons are up by 41%, Preschool registration began March 13th and we currently have well over 50% of this year's registration and fitness visits rose almost 7% from February of 2018 to 2019.
- H. Superintendent of Recreation Muenz informed the Board of the Easter festivities next month: Brunch with the Bunny April 13th, Egg Dive April 19th and Egg Hunt April 20th.

President Janiec stated that he was very dissatisfied with the Easter Egg Hunt last year and thought that we might need an extra 1 or 2 staff members to help out. He also said he has contacted the police to see if they could walk the grounds to make sure there won't be any trouble.

- I. Assistant Superintendent of Parks & Planning Pickett stated that staff had worked on the budget.
- J. Assistant Superintendent of Parks & Planning Pickett said that staff has been picking up garbage, taking the pesticide tests and taking care of things outdoors.
- **K.** Assistant Superintendent of Parks & Planning Pickett informed the Board that Parks Supervisor Matt Page is getting the soccer fields ready for next week.
- L. Assistant Superintendent of Parks & Planning Pickett told the Board that Park Pride day will be on May 18th and if anyone is interested in helping out they should contact him.
- M. Executive Director Stein thanked the staff for their help with the budget.
- N. Executive Director Stein informed the Board that tomorrow he will be meeting with Assistant Superintendent of Parks & Planning Pickett and staff from W-T Group and Hitchcock Design regarding Commissioners' Park.
