E-Verify resources for employees

Streamwood Park District complies with the United States Department of Homeland Security (U.S. Citizenship and Immigration Services) to verify the employment eligibility of all persons hired to work in the United States. The Park District will provide the Social Security Administration (SSA) and the Department of Homeland Security (DHS), with information from each new employee's Form I-9 to confirm work authorization.

Streamwood Park District maintains full compliance with all regulations set forth by the law and utilizes E-Verify to assist in ensuring a legal workforce. An E-Verify case will be created no later than the third business day after the employee starts work for pay.

An I-9 Form, which is supplied at the time of hire must be completed by the first date of work.
